League Rules

High School Basketball Rules will be used except as follows:

1. Clock-Games will consist of Two (2) Twenty (20) minute halves. The clock will run continuously except for the last minute of each half when it will be stopped as in a regular game. The clock will always be stopped on a team Time-out. Overtime periods will be Two (2) minutes long. The half-time break will be Three (3) minutes long.
2. Time-Outs-Each team is permitted to use two (2) Time-Outs Regulation per half. Time-Outs do not carry over to the second half or overtime periods. One additional Time-Out per team may be used in overtime.
3. Foul Shots-Each player will shoot 2 foul shots beginning on the other team's tenth (10) Team foul of the half. Anytime a player is fouled in the act of shooting 2 or 3 foul shots will be awarded.
4. Conduct-No swearing or taunting will be allowed and will result in a technical plus a 5-minute cool down. You will automatically be ejected from the game if: 1) You are caught fighting; 2) You receive 2 technical fouls in one game. 3) Officials decision. Being ejected from a game will result in a one game suspension. Any player ejected from a game will be required to meet with a league director and the coach before being able to participate in the next game. You must also attend your teams next game and devotion. Four technicals in the course of the season will result in removal from the league. League directors have the right to remove someone from the league. Tournaments – the league directors reserve the right to request ID.
5. Coaches-If the Coach is unable to attend the game they should call the church and tell them the name of your substitute. If the Coach or an approved substitute is not in attendance the team will forfeit. The Coach is responsible for making sure that his/her team understands all of the rules for this league. It will be your responsibility to set the example for the appropriate behavior of your team and to have control over your players in all situations that may occur. Mutual respect for each other will be required of all participants.
6. Players-All players must remove all jewelry (including earrings), hats or any other items other than Basketball equipment before stepping onto the floor for warm-ups or games. Mutual respect for each other will be required of all participants
7. Before Games-All players and coaches from both teams will meet on the court together before the start of each game for an opening prayer. After the completion of each game all players and coaches from both teams will meet in a designated area for a brief (5-10 minutes) devotional talk. Parents and friends are also invited to attend. **Attendance is mandatory for players.**
