"Prelude to Power" Acts 2:1-13

August 1, 2010

Dr. David Oliver

1. We need to move from being _____ to being disciples. If you and I want the power of God in our lives, we must _____. No genuine believer in Jesus can sit on the fence. We must actively seek to be disciples, becoming true *followers* of Jesus Christ.
2. There is _____ in the name of Jesus Christ. He gives you and me the power to overcome evil and to do God's will. His power is like no other force on earth. It is time for genuine followers to move from talking about this power into the *personal experience* of this power. The power of the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential for each of us to live the Christian life. If we do not have this power working within us, we may have good _____ but not much practice, good _____ but not much fruit. *It is only when the principles of Christ are combined with the power of Christ, that we have _____ which can warm and transform the world.*
3. Jesus was a _____. If we want power in our work as disciples of Christ, then we too must become servant leaders. Servant leadership means placing the _____ before our own needs. It means making sacrifices.
4. Jesus knows each of us better than we know ourselves, all the good and bad about us. He will not cease to love us until he brings about a _____ in our hearts and eternal salvation to our lives. This happens because the power of God, released at Pentecost, is _____ and channeled into our lives. We need to pray for and seek this power until we receive it. No matter what we have done, it is not beyond the boundless providence and power of God to forgive. When we deny him, he comes to us and restores us and calls us to continue serving him. This is not an invitation to sin more or to take his forgiveness lightly. Rather, this is an invitation to _____, to humbly confess our sin, and to seek his healing power and grace to live differently, to live authentically, and to live greatly for his greater glory.
